Mayor Anderson called the meeting to order with roll call.

New Business:

Fiscal Officer Position

Discussion followed concerning the resignation of Linda Pleiman as Fiscal Officer, and how Council wished to proceed with filling the vacant position. Ads were placed in the Sidney Daily news, on the Village's website and Facebook page. Council requested that it also be placed on the OML website. In the past there was discussion concerning making either the Fiscal Officer or Clerk position part-time.

This would be a prime opportunity to re-create the Fiscal Officer position to part-time. Benroth and Anderson stated that Maurer is doing an excellent job and has really organized and made Mayor's Court more professional and citizen friendly. She's willing to do anything extra that is needed and they would like her position to remain full-time. Dialogue followed as to the parameters of the position and it was decided that no decision would be made on the position until the applications are reviewed. The viable candidates may only want part-time work or may need full-time hours. This would determine the criteria for the position. Applications are due my July 17, 2015. It was decided that any Council member can stop in and peruse the applications in the afternoon on July 21, 2015. Each member can note which they feel should be interviewed. The ones with majority votes will be scheduled for interviews.
